**Temari:****A. Fluency in speaking and listening**

This block is based on practice activities centred on the following functions: (1) description, (2) narration, (3) argumentation, (4) explanation, (5) instructions, and (6) conversation.

**B. Studying spoken English**

In this block students will analyse samples of spoken English produced by native speakers and by themselves from the point of view of their most characteristic lexical and grammatical features. The samples by native speakers focus on the following functions: narrative, talking about oneself, language in action, opinion, service encounter, debating, producing a speech, and negotiating future action. The samples produced by the students will correspond to the speaking activities in the Electronic Dossier.

**C. Functions in English**

This block includes practice activities in which students will develop their knowledge and skills related to the expression of particular pragmatic functions in English in different contexts.

Function 1: Asking for information

Function 2: Getting people to do things

Function 3: Conversation techniques

Function 4: Future: intention and probability

Function 5: Offering to do something, asking permission

Function 6: Giving opinions

Function 7: Suggestions, advice, persuading

Function 8: Complaining, apologising, forgiving

**D. Aspects of usage**

In this block students will be given an opportunity to revise and increase their knowledge of particular aspects related to using English grammar.

- Verbal tenses - Definite article
- Modal auxiliary verbs - Conditional sentences
- Relative clauses - Inversion
- Passive forms - Emphasis
- Direct and reported speech - Verbs followed by -ing or infinitive

**Objectius:**

Llengua Anglesa IV is essentially devoted to providing the students with appropriate practice to improve and reflect upon their speaking and listening skills in English. The programme includes four main blocks with contents which the students are expected to have covered at the end of the course.

**Activitats acadèmicament dirigides:**

- (1) Class attendance and participation.
- (2) 'Comments' portfolio: This document must include comments that were made in class and that contributed to increasing the student's knowledge about the structure and use of English. To be handed in on the day of the final examination.
- (3) 'Practice' portfolio: This document must include two 'supplementary practice' exercises for each of the topics included in Aspects of Usage. A minimum of two different sources must be used.

(4) Participation in a minimum of 4 'chat sessions' of 40-45 minutes outside regular class hours and in groups of 3-4 students. Each student is responsible for transcribing a segment of 6-8 minutes from two different sessions. The complete recordings of the 4 sessions must be handed in as well. VERY IMPORTANT: Each session must be initiated dealing with a specific topic which will be used as the title of the session; in each session each student will first introduce himself/herself and make a contribution about the topic in question.

(5) Practicals: The regular course load includes 1 hour 'cpe' which corresponds to the time the students should invest every week in doing one practical assigned by the instructor outside regular class hours. There are two different types of practicals:

(a) Speaking and listening (sources: 'Speaking dossier' -in paper support- and Listening dossier -as electronic dossier-; to be done in pairs): weeks 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13.

(b) Fluency in speaking and listening (source: Itacampus; to be done individually): weeks 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14.

All the practicals must be handed in during the following week in digital, audio or paper support, depending on the type of activities involved.

Each of the Speaking and listening practicals will include at least one speaking and one listening activity. The speaking activity must be tape-recorded and handed in together with a one-page transcript corresponding to a segment of the speech produced during the activity.

(6) Tutorials: There are two obligatory tutorials for each "chat group" in weeks 6 and 12 of the term, in which the members of the group will update the instructor on their personal progress in connection with the aims and requirements of the course.
